### The essence of a unique grape variety

Our Signature Wine. Tribute to our Antona García, "The Immortal", reflects the soul of Tinta de Toro through passion, with a distinctive elaboration based on respect for a unique vineyard, our Finca Miralmonte, which is the soul of the intensity and minerality that define this wine.

### Vineyard and soils

Vineyard and soilsIts personality is marked by its original vineyard, Finca Miralmonte, planted by hand and ungrafted in 1953 and managed organically and respectfully with the environment. Sandy soil that stands out for the gravel and boulders found on its surface, making the sun that shines on them reflect on the most hidden clusters among its vines, improving aromatic ripening and providing a unique personality.

### Winemaking and aging

Manual harvest with an initial selection in the vineyard. The process aims to maintain the total integrity of the berry until the end of its cold pre-fermentation maceration. Fermentation in stainless steel at low temperature allows for optimal aromatic extraction without excessive tannin.

Aging for 12 months in new French and Hungarian oak barrels, with a prior conditioning period of one and a half months to remove the most intense toasted notes from the wood, ensuring that Antona García rests without the wood altering its profile. This is a creative process marked by precision and attention to every detail. A small portion ages in acacia barrels, which enhance its floral notes and increase its complexity.

## Tasting Note

Subtle and elegant, with strength and personality. Garnet color with a violet rim, typical of the variety. On the nose, it presents high intensity, blending notes of red fruits, florals, balsamics, and minerals in a composition that resonates from the vineyard, complemented by light spiciness contributed by barrel aging. The palate is smooth and velvety, with balanced acidity and lingering hints of red currant and blackberry found on the nose, a true reflection of an extraordinary terroir.







# Antona García

## Passion

### Her legend

Antona García is the great heroine of the city of Toro since 1476. At that time, Toro was besieged by the Portuguese, and the Castilian troops of Isabella of Castile were marching to reclaim the city. Antona García, a noblewoman born among the common people, lived in her palace within the city walls. There, together with other Castilian nobles, she devised a plan to help the Castilian troops reconquer the city. In the summer of 1476, with Isabella's troops at the gates, Antona García showed them a secret entrance to the city, allowing them to infiltrate and reclaim Toro. As a result, Antona García was accused of treason by the Portuguese invaders and executed at the window of her own palace. Days later, a victorious Isabella of Castile would visit Toro to honor this woman from Toro, ordering the gilding of the palace's wrought iron gate where Antona García had upheld her nobility and loyalty to the people of Castile, bestowing upon her the title of "The Immortal" and thus giving birth to the palace of Rejadorada.

Her sacrifice and courage were forever etched in the gate and in the memory of Toro, making her a legendary figure and an emblem of loyalty and the fight for freedom.





#### Her reflection in the wine

Antona García has historically been portrayed as a woman ahead of her time, with clear ideas and a strong personality. She is also described as a very beautiful woman, with an appearance that combined elegance, nobility, and character. In seeking to honor her figure in a wine, we chose the Finca Miralmonte as the only vineyard capable of providing a Tinta de Toro with the refinement and aromatic intensity that could encapsulate the essence of our Antona García. The subtle aging in French and Hungarian oak barrels strengthens her winemaking philosophy, reflected in every glass: a modern-style crianza wine, intense, fruity, and elegant.

A wine capable of honoring the figure of "The Immortal", which, like her, combines character and delicacy, offering a new vision of Tinta de Toro, a true reflection of our history..
